This Memorandum of Understanding entered into this ____ day of ___, 20__ by and between _____ with its principal location at _____ hereinafter referred to as Referring Entity, and Addiction Research and Treatment, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as BAART), with its principal location at 1111 Market Street, 4th Floor, San Francisco, CA 94103. This Memorandum of Understanding shall become effective _____ and shall remain in effect until such time that either BAART or Referring Entity wish to terminate same. In such cases, written notice is given to the appropriate party (BAART or Referring Entity depending on the originator of the requested action) within thirty (30) days or less prior to the effective date of the termination of the contractual relationship.

WHEREAS, BAART is qualified to provide specialized expertise in the field of drug treatment and rehabilitation services, including medication assisted therapy (MAT), and opioid treatment programs either individually or as a wrap around to primary medical care and behavioral health services; and

WHEREAS Referring Entity has a need for the specialized expertise in the field of drug treatment and rehabilitation programs as it pertains to integrated primary care services;

NOW THEREFORE, BAART AND Referring Entity agree as follows:

I STATEMENT OF WORK

When Referring Entity is reasonably certain that the patient meets ASAM patient placement criteria for Narcotic Replacement Therapy (NRT) defined as:

- 0.5 = Early Intervention Services
- OMT = Opioid Maintenance Therapy - Criteria for Level I Outpatient OMT, but OMT in all levels

BAART will engage in initial needs assessment to verify criteria for admission. Under 42 CFR regulations and upon signature of Consent to Release Information, BAART will disclose status of patient's admission to referring entity. Upon admission, BAART will engage in intermittent and ongoing assessment, treatment planning, individual and /or group therapy services, and appropriate discharge planning that is consistent with relevant MAT guidelines. BAART and Referring Entity will engage in joint case collaboration and case management based on Referring Entity medical dictates and will jointly determine content and frequency of communication regarding individual treatment planning and patient outcome information.

II. PERIOD

BAART and Subcontract shall be considered entered into this Agreement on the ____ day of _____, 20__.

III. RECORDS

Each party shall be responsible for any and all performance of it under this Agreement. Each party shall maintain such records and accounts, including financial records, as are deemed necessary for each to assure a proper accounting for all applicable funds, and/or as required by Statute. Such records, if applicable, shall be maintained currently and properly from program, financial, and other management audits; and retrained for at least five (5) years after the expiration of this Agreement.

IV. COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE LAW

Each party shall comply with the requirements of all Federal, State, and local laws, ordinances, rules, regulations, manuals, guidelines, Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards, and directives applicable to its performance hereunder. Further, all provisions required, thereby, to be included in this Agreement are hereby incorporated herein by reference.

V. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

The body of this agreement shall constitute the complete and exclusive statement of understanding between the parties which supersedes all previous agreements, written or oral, and all other communications between the parties relating to the subject matter of this Agreement.
